Background

In December 2022, PAFFREL launched the Sri Lanka Reform Tracker, an interactive online platform to monitor reforms and proposals submitted by parliamentarians, stakeholders, and the public. The Tracker includes features such as a polling system, progress monitoring, and a public commenting space to engage citizens in governance. Under the RNE Project “Strengthening Democracy through Engaging Citizens in Accountable Governance” (Outcome 4), PAFFREL is now working to further develop the Tracker into a more updated and user-friendly tool for monitoring electoral reforms, providing citizens with timely information and fostering active participation in the reform process.

Objectives of the Meeting

- Introduction to the SL Reform Tracker.
- Explain the legal status of Parliament Acts and Bills, describe the complete path of a Bill through legislation with relevant experiences, and respond to participant questions related to the discussion.
- Provide technical training for participants on the SL Reform Tracker.
